1.1 THE COURSE, approximately 1400 NM

Starting line defined in Attachment 2

- Side buoy "Charles Martel" to be left on starboard: 48°18.950 N - 004°41.900W.
- Side buoy "Le Trepied" to be left on port 48°16.700 N - 004°41.500 W
- Turret "La Parquette" to be left to port: 48°15.900 N - 004°44.300 W.
- South Cardinal Buoy "Basse Royale" to be left to starboard: 48°17.450 N - 004°49.600 W.
- South Cardinal Buoy "Pierres Noires" to be left to starboard: 48°18.470 N - 004°58.148 W.
- OUESSANT Island to be left to starboard.
- Waypoint : « Tout Commence en Finistère » to be left on starboard: 46° 30' 00 N / 009° 00' 00 W
- Fastnet TSS: forbidden area to be rounded to port.
- Fastnet Rock to be rounded to port (51°23, 3 N / 009°36.1 W).
- Fastnet TSS: forbidden area to be rounded to port.
- **Waypoint Région Bretagne to be rounded to starboard 48°00'00. N / 007°15.00 W**
- **Waypoint Gallimard to be rounded to starboard 49°00'00. N / 014°00.00 W**
- OUESSANT Island to be left to port.
- South Cardinal Buoy "Pierres Noires" to be left to port: 48°18.470 N - 004°58.148 W.
- South Cardinal Buoy "Basse Royale" to be left to port: 48°17.450 N - 004°49.600 W.
- Turret "La Parquette" to be left to starboard: 48°15.900 N - 004°44.300 W.
- *** Side buoy "Charles Martel" to be left to port: 48°18.950 N - 004°41.900W.**
- ***Toulinguet point lighthouse to be left to starboard:**
