### 1/ DOCUMENTS TO BE RETURNED TO THE ORGANISATION

- Digital or paper version of the registration form duly filled out and signed
- Ensure you're up-to-date with your FFV 2022 licence
  - FFV 'competition' licence 2022
  - Or valid 'member' licence accompanied by a medical certificate with no contraindications to the practice of sailing, including competitive sailing
  - For overseas competitors who do not have an FFV licence, please present:
    - A medical certificate with no contraindications to the practice of competitive sailing dating less than one year
    - A certificate showing third-party insurance amounting to 1.5-million Euros.
- Copy of the boat's insurance certificate.
- Copy of the 2022 advertising card for sponsored boats (Compulsory for French and overseas FFV members who display advertising on their boat)

- Proof of payment of all the registration fees
- Copy of the World Sailing training certificate (Sea Survival + PS MER)
- Medical file comprising:
  - The results of an exercise tolerance test dating less than 4 years

## 3/ IN THE RUN-UP TO THE RACE

### Safety equipment check

The 'typical' inspection sheet for safety equipment will be provided at a later date, together with the methods for booking an appointment with the event measurer or inspectors to get your boat checked prior to the race.

Please note that the Guyader Bermudes 1000 Race is in the OSR 1 category.

### Installation of beacons

Positioning beacons will be installed aboard the IMOCAs prior to the start. The organiser will detail the appointment times for installing the beacons at a later date.

## 4/ RECEPTION IN BREST

Your arrival in Brest is possible **from 2 May**. The boats and competitors (or the competitor's representative) shall be available to the OA no later than **Thursday 5 May 2022 at 17:00 hours** in the Port du Château in Brest.

The fleet will be berthed in the Bassin d'escalas in the Port du Château and on the other side, along the Quai Commandant Malbert (see plan below)

Pierre Hays is in charge of your reception. When leaving your port of registry, please give him an ETA via text (+33 (0)6 98 31 48 78) and email (pierre.hays22@gmail.com) and provide a more precise ETA 1hr before your arrival.

A technical car park will be set up close to the dock. **A single vehicle per team** can be parked here. Badges will be distributed upon your arrival.



## [5/ RACE HQ/ PRESS HQ / YACHT CLUB IMOCA](#)

Race HQ/Press HQ will be located at **145 quai Eric Tabarly** from Thursday 5 to Saturday 14 May.

The Yacht Club IMOCA will be located at **55 quai Eric Tabarly, level with La Rotonde – Salle des Records in the Marina** from Thursday 4 to Sunday 8 May then from Thursday 12 to Saturday 14 May. This space will be reserved for boat operators and skippers.

## [6/ SPEED RUNS](#)

Speed runs will take place on **Friday 6 May between 13:30 and 16:30 hours**. The runs will be done in **crewed format** close to the Pen Ar Vir zone (opposite the naval college)

One place will be reserved aboard each IMOCA for the organisation and all the boats will have to perform **at least one run**. A trophy will be awarded to the winner of the runs.

## 7/ START DAY

The start is scheduled for **Sunday 8 May at 14:00 hrs** with the start line located at the exit from Brest narrows, level with Bertheaume cove.

## 8/ THE FINISH IN BREST

### Prize-giving

The prize-giving will take place on **Saturday 14 May**. You will be informed about the schedule and venue shortly.

## 9/ OFFICIAL BRANDING OF THE BOATS

Every boat competing in the Guyader Bermudes 1000 Race shall display:

- 1 Guyader Bermudes 1000 Race sticker on the starboard side of the mainsail. Stickers will be **available at the Class IMOCA office between 21 and 25 March**.
- 2 race flags to be attached to the running backstays during sea passages.
- Distributed upon the arrival of the boats in Brest, any partner flags shall be hoisted along the length of the forestay and shall remain in position until 2 hours before the start and as soon as possible at the finish in Brest.



## 10/ PROGRAMME FOR THE GUYADER BERMUDES 1000 RACE

### **From 2 to 4 May:**

Safety checks for the boats in their ports of registry

### **Thursday 5 May:**

17:00 hrs: Deadline for the boats to arrive at the Port du Château in Brest

18:00 hrs: Welcome cocktail at the Yacht Club Guyader Bermudes 1000 Race

### **Friday 6 May:**

13:30 to 16:30 hrs – Organisation of runs in Brest harbour – Compulsory, non-point-scoring.

### **Saturday 7 May:**

17:30 hrs: Official photo – Compulsory presence of the competitors

18:00 hrs: Skippers' briefing at the Yacht Club Guyader Bermudes 1000 Race – Compulsory presence of the competitors

### **Sunday 8 May:**

14:00 hrs: Start of the Guyader - Bermudes 1000 Race

### **Saturday 14 May:**

Prize-giving - Compulsory presence of the competitors (venue and time to be confirmed)

All the boats must remain in the port of Brest until Sunday 15 May at 08:00 hrs, unless they have special dispensation from RM
