- Digital or paper version of the registration form duly filled out and signed
- Ensure you're up-to-date with your FFV 2022 licence
 - o FFV 'competition' licence 2022
 - o Or valid 'member' licence accompanied by a medical certificate with no contraindications to the practice of sailing, including competitive sailing
 - o For overseas competitors who do not have an FFV licence, please present:
 - A medical certificate with no contraindications to the practice of competitive sailing dating less than one year
 - A certificate showing third-party insurance amounting to 1.5-million Euros.
- Copy of the boat's insurance certificate.
- Copy of the 2022 advertising card for sponsored boats (Compulsory for French and overseas FFV members who display advertising on their boat)

- Proof of payment of all the registration fees
- Copy of the World Sailing training certificate (Sea Survival + PS MER)
- Medical file comprising:
 - o The results of an exercise tolerance test dating less than 4 years

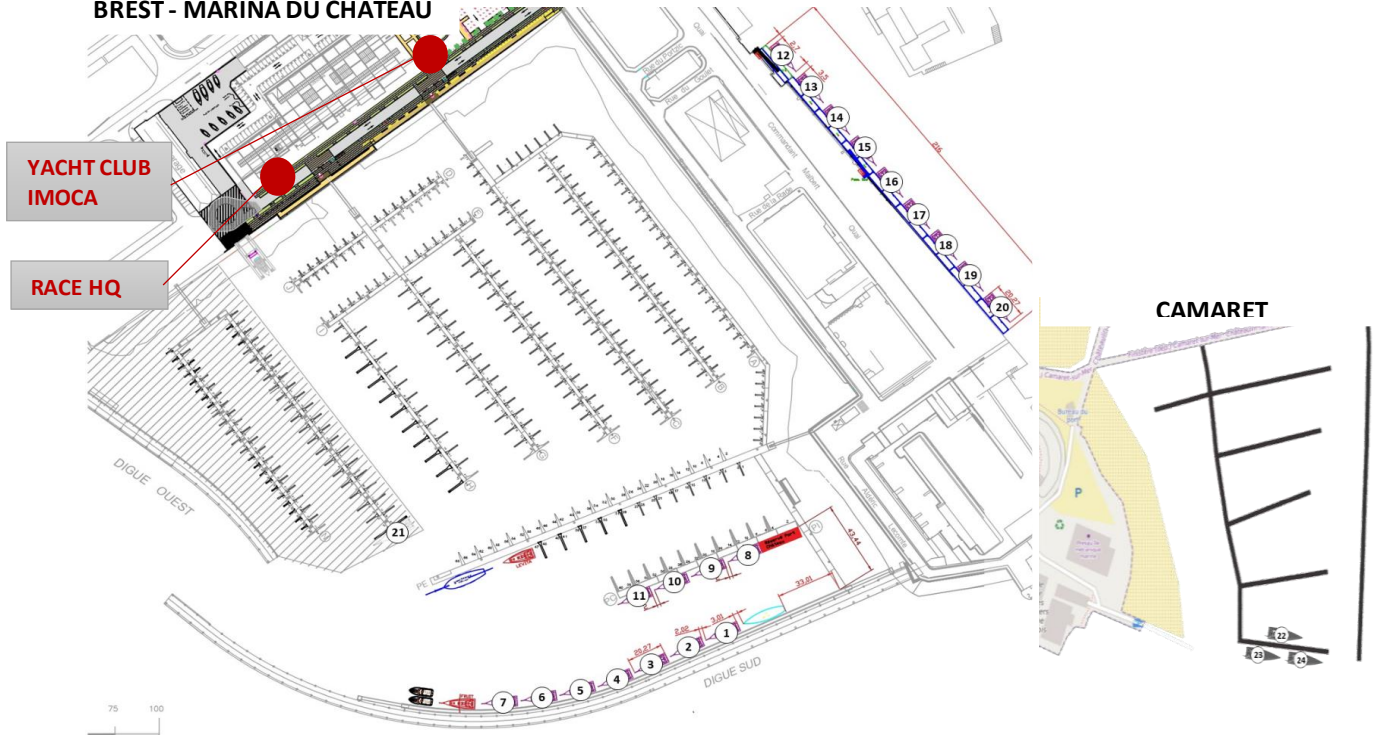
4/ BERTHING AND VENUES

FOR THE DEPARTURE

- 21 boats** will be moored in Port du Château
- 3 boats** will be moored in Camaret / The last 3 entries on the list [see plan in the last page](#)
Options are being studied to house the entire fleet in Brest.
- Free access to the port is planned from May 4**, except for boats that have scheduled their security checks in advance.
- Pierre Hays** is in charge of your reception in Brest. When leaving your port of registry, please give him your ETA via text (+33 (0)6983 14878) and email (pierre.hays22@gmail.com) and refine this again 1hr before your arrival.
- A technical car park will be set up close to the dock. **A single vehicle per team** can be parked here. A badge must be picked up from Race HQ upon your arrival in Brest.
- Race HQ** will be located at 145 quai Eric Tabarly from Thursday 5 to Saturday 14 May.
 - Press HQ** will be located on the ground floor of the Espace Giraudeau / Capitainerie from Friday 6 to Sunday 8 May then at 145 quai Eric Tabarly (next to Race HQ) from 9 May

- The Yacht Club IMOCA will be located at the Espace Giraudeau – Salle des Records / Capitainerie. This venue will be reserved for all the skippers and their partners, so everyone is free to interact and socialise. This space will be open from **Friday 6 May at 17:00 hrs to Sunday 8 May at 20:00 hrs**. We will hand out **5 bracelets per team** to access the Yacht Club.

FOR THE ARRIVAL :

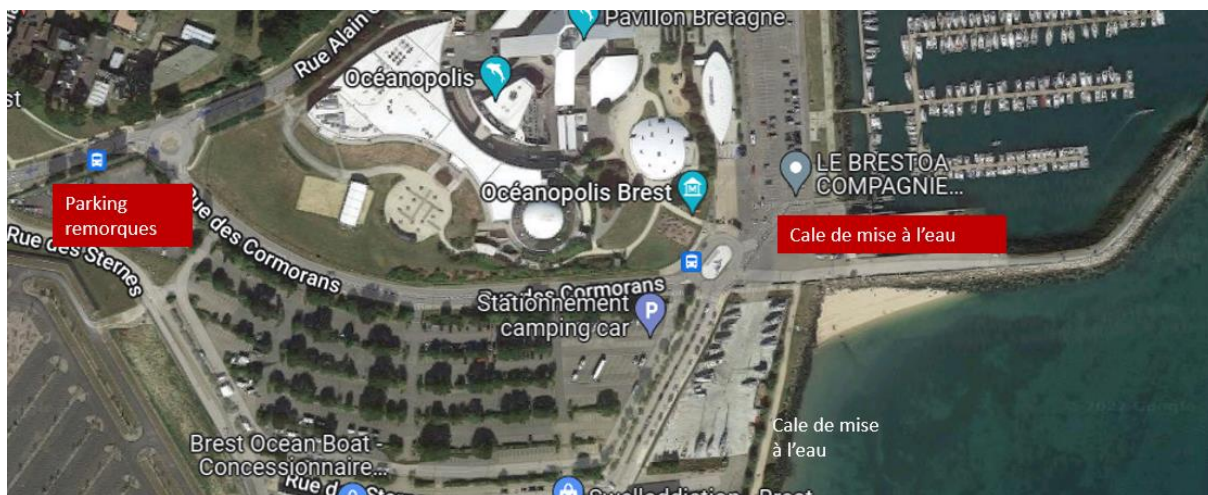
- The first 12 boats will have to stay in the port of Brest until Sunday, May 15, 08h.

- Ribs will be moored alongside the boats.

8/ OFFICIAL BRANDING OF THE BOATS

Every boat competing in the Guyader Bermudes 1000 Race shall display:

- **1 Guyader Bermudes 1000 Race sticker** on the starboard side of the mainsail.
- **2 race flags** to be attached to the running backstays during sea passages.
- Distributed upon the arrival of the boats in Brest, any partner flags shall be hoisted along the length of the forestay and shall remain in position until 2 hours before the start and as soon as possible at the finish in Brest.
